## Capt. Muhammad, Founder of The Peacekeepers Visits Flint "Squash The Beef Before The Grief" Violence Intervention



Capt. Dennis Muhammad, Founder of The Peacekeepers Global Initiative was in Flint, MI this month to introduce the Peacekeepers violence interruption plan. Capt. Dennis announced plans to establish a "Peacekeepers Squash the Beef Conflict Mediation Center". This center will allow Flint youth in particular and our community in general to have a place to come to when they have a beef or conflict. "We will give them Conflict Resolution counseling" said Capt. Dennis. The new center will address some of the social issues in our community also. This initiative will come with the necessary funding in order to guarantee its success.

The program was very informative. It was moderated by Jalil X, Director and Spokesperson for the Flint Peacekeepers. Speakers included Pastor Devontae Powell of Vermont Christian Church, Student Minister Laron Muhammad Flint Study Group #53, and DeWaun Robinson of Black Lives Matter Flint.



## Peacekeepers "One Hour Of Power" At Midway Square Apts.

Shortly after reporting to complete the "One Hour of Power" on Saturday, October 7, Peacekeepers were met by a screaming mother asking for help to find her missing child. After devising a plan and then assembling to begin the search for the child the Flint Police Department arrived and joined the search. While searching for the child another set of Flint officers arrived stating they had received a call about a black female child missing. Both children were found during the Peacekeepers "One Hour Of Power". Officers from Flint Michigan police department transported the children back home.



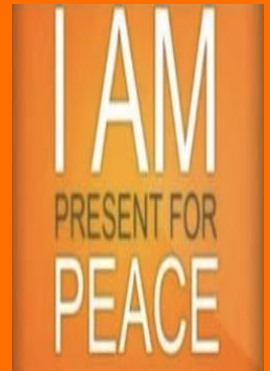
## Table-Talk With Flint Peacekeepers

Also present were Administrator of The Flint Chapter Peacekeepers Linda Muhammad and Sgt. of Arms of Flint Peacekeepers Rodney Thomas.
